The Conecuh County Commission held their regular scheduled Commission Meeting on Tuesday, June 28, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. at in the Conecuh County Government Center in the City of Evergreen.

Chairman Leonard Millender called the meeting to order.

5. Winston Foshee-EMA Director/ Engineer Report:

Commissioner Riley informed the board that the State would give the county a 12-drawer cooler estimated at \$80,000. Commissioner Riley stated he really wish the board would consider the free cooler. Commissioner Riley stated where the cooler exists now, the person wants it on that property for their use and that is not benefiting the County. Commissioner Riley stated he thinks the coroner should decide where the morgue goes and not the funeral home.

Commissioner Campbell was asked along with Commissioner Riley and Michael Lambert to see what is the best option. Commissioner Campbell stated he has been working with Mr. Keahey and a 2- body cooler is all we really need.

Commissioner Campbell presented the board with a 2-body cooler quote in the amount of \$11,223.00.

Commissioner Byrd seconded the motion; Commissioners Byrd Campbell, Dewberry and Chairman Millender voted yes; Commissioner Riley voted no.

With no further business to discuss, Chairman Millender asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting.


Commissioner Campbell made a motion to adjourn the Commission Meeting. Commissioner Byrd seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
